PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Families,

Tomorrow we celebrate the start of our 2022 school year with a Mass as a school community. Our children will come together outside to celebrate Mass with Fr Denis and Fr Janu. During this Mass we will commission our 2022 Student Leaders, Colour House Leaders and Student Representative Council. These children will be anointed with the Oil of Chrism and take their Leadership Oath before the school community.

The oil of Chrism is an important element in significant Catholic rituals. Chrism is an oil made with Myrrh. Using the oil in this way represents an anointing by the Holy Spirit. In the Old Testament times, those who became priests or Kings had oil poured on their heads and the Spirit of the Lord came to them. This anointing also calls us back to our anointing during the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation.



We will be praying for God to bestow His blessings on these students as they take up their role of leadership in our school. We will also pray for God's blessing and guidance for all our students and community as we seek to achieve our goals and live our Mercy Carmelite values of:

Compassion, Dignity and Justice.

This Mass will not only mark the official beginning of a new school year but it will also be our first event in marking our school centenary. During the Mass, Fr Denis will bless a special gift that all our students will receive to commemorate this special year.

Unfortunately our parents will not be able to join us in person, but we hope you can join us virtually as we share the celebration via Facebook live.

RAT TESTING & ALERTS

Thank you to all of our families who are following the process of surveillance testing on Monday and Wednesday morning before sending children to school. Please remember that any positive tests **MUST be reported to the school via a phone call to the School Office or an email to the School email address**. For the safety of all students, it is important that no student carries medication on them or in their bags at any time. If your child requires temporary medication for a short period of time, please bring the medication to the school office and complete the relevant forms.

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

Are you a safe pedestrian at pick up time? Do you model safe pedestrian behaviour for your child by using the zebra crossing?

Since the beginning of the school year we have noticed that in the afternoon a large number of parents are unsafely walking their children straight across the road after leaving the three gated zones. Miss Pirovic and Mrs Anderiesz have witnessed a number of 'near misses' where people crossing in this unsafe manner are almost causing accidents. It is not safe for you to walk out in front of traffic where the view of pedestrians is obstructed by moving cars. We are asking all parents, who need to cross the road, walk up to the numerous zebra crossings that surround our school and cross at these designated safe locations. We know it's a little bit further, but think of the extra steps you get and more importantly the precious lives you keep safe. We thank all parents for following this procedure to ensure that all members of our school community are safe.




HIGH SCHOOL ENROLMENTS
