SCHOOL UNIFORM AND HAIRCUTS

We ask that children wear full school uniform at all times and for parents' support in ensuring appropriate haircuts upon returning to school at the commencement of 2023 in full Summer uniform.

Haircuts

Boys - Neat, simple and tidy haircuts, no undercuts or colouring, no shorter than a number 2, no rat tails or patterns or lines shaved in, cuts should be graduated without obvious difference in length.

Girls - Shoulder length or longer hair must be tied back. No hair colouring is permitted. Hair ties, ribbons and headbands must be white, blue or school uniform pattern. Cultural braided additions must be a natural colour without beading. (Please note the final decision is at the discretion of the principal)

Summer Uniform

Boys - Navy blue shorts, school crest blue shirt with collar and short sleeves, school zip jacket or fleecy jumper, short grey school socks with blue/gold band, black school shoes (not trainers), school hat.

Girls - Blue and white check dress with piping around neck, school zip jacket or fleecy jumper, white socks, black school shoes (not trainers), white, royal blue or school uniform check pattern ribbons/hair ties, school hat.

Sport - unisex royal blue sport shorts with school initials, unisex royal blue short sleeved polo shirt with school crest, white ankle socks that are visible above the shoe, trainers that are - white, blue or black.

School hats and bags are required by all children.

Our school uniform supplier is OzFashions, parents are able to place orders via the QKR app. Unfortunately, the next uniform delivery will be after the start of the school year.

MAI: INTERVIEW NOTES

Once again we will be conducting Mathematics Assessment Interviews with all our children in 2023. We have allocated time on Friday 27 and Monday 30 January 2023 to begin these interviews. Assigning two full days for these interviews is a massive allocation of time and energy. In the last few years, we have noticed a decline in student numbers attending interviews, as parents choose to enjoy the last few days of the holidays.

While we know that there is not an interview time for every child in the school, we are asking parents to make a concerted effort in booking and attending these interviews as they support the teacher's knowledge of your child and reduce the amount of time your child's teacher has to be released in the first four weeks of the school year.

We expect to see most of our children during these two days and ask parents to use the instructions on the note that was sent home last Friday. If you need to cancel an appointment please do so via the school interviews website. This allows other families to book in the time slot you are no longer able to make.

E-SAFETY FOR FAMILIES



As we move closer to the holidays, many parents will need to keep working while some of our older students will remain at home, most likely with older siblings. While your older children may be responsible, this supervision is very different to that of a parent. So, now is the time for our families to evaluate the expectations, safety measures and restrictions in place to ensure your child remains safe online.

Access to the internet and digital technologies provide many benefits, however, we must also be aware that this comes with a unique set of challenges. Do not assume that your child 'knows' how to be safe online, or 'understands' the long-lasting impact of their digital footprint. While students learn about this at school, these are lessons they will continue to learn into adulthood. The <u>eSafety Commissioner</u> is an Australian Government body that provides support and information for parents about online safety. It covers topics such as online safety, social media, screen time and inappropriate content. The website also provides tips on how to tackle difficult conversation about the inappropriate content with your children. As parents it is important to set expectations around device use and regularly check your child's activity.

LIBRARY NEWS

It's time to return your library books!! During this week we ask all parents to help their children search at home for any stray library or class reading books allocated to your child. The teachers will contact parents if there are anv outstanding guided reading books. Each child is allocated a numbered copy to make tracking the books easier. These readers are a part of a set and if they are not returned this makes the sets unusable for reading instruction.
