CUMBERLAND POLICE YOUTH LIAISON VISIT Yr1-Yr6

Dear Families,

As part of our ongoing focus on ensuring our students are safe and respectful learners, a Youth Liaison Officer from Cumberland Police will be visiting all classroom spaces.

Senior Constable El-Jammal will attend OLMC on Wednesday 17 March to speak to Stage 2 and Stage 3 students (Year 3 – Year 6), focusing on bullying, harassment and cyber safety. Topics such as personal settings, profile pages, sending images online, mobile devices, ‘send’ is definite, cyber bullying and appropriate behaviours towards others will be covered.

Senior Constable El-Jammal will also attend OLMC on Monday 30 May to speak to Stage 1 & Year 3 (Year 1 - Year 3) to speak to students about childhood safety and stranger danger. This program aims to help children identify the safe adults in their community, as well as safe places to go when they are lost, feeling unsafe or frightened or are in danger. Other goals include enabling children to develop their own personal safety strategies, to feel empowered with the ability to say NO and seek help when they feel unsafe or unsure, and to have the confidence to tell a trusted adult if they are being harmed in any way.

This visit by Senior Constable El-Jammal will complement our ongoing focus of community safety and the learnings occurring through K-6 PDH units.
