#### Dear Families,

On Saturday, as a parish community, we celebrated Confirmation and then on Sunday the Feast of Pentecost. How fitting that our students' celebration of their Confirmation, the sacrament in which the gifts of the Holy Spirit are received to support a life long journey as a faith filled servant leader, coincided with Pentecost, a feast which commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles to support their servant leadership mission. 

# SUBMITTING ATTENDANCE THROUGH COMPASS


