Dear Families,

Our Easter continues. During the years after Jesus' death, the earliest followers of Jesus were called the followers of 'the Way'. The Christian label came into use later. In one sense, it was a type of code word. one that only Jesus' followers would understand, especially because they were under threat of persecution. In another sense, it shows that they took Jesus' words, retold to us in the Gospel, seriously.

During the Easter events Jesus was preparing his disciples for the time when he would no longer be physically present to guide them to God the Father. He also reminded them that there is a place for us all in God's home. Jesus tells us, his disciples.....


> I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No one can come to the Father except through me. If you know me, you know my Father too. From this moment you know him and have seen him.

One approach to interpreting Jesus' meaning is the idea of mentorship. For example, if you want to be a carpenter, you could work with someone who is a carpenter and watch how he or she works. By watching and learning from the master carpenter, you are trained to become a carpenter yourself. Or, if you want to have a beautiful garden, you can observe and work with someone who has a green thumb. This master gardener will teach you how to care for your own garden.

If we want to have a place in God's house, we need to look at the way Jesus lived and acted towards others. If we copy his life and actions, we are on the right

way to God.

The Power of Yet

There's a theme catching fire around OLMC and it has to do with an itty bitty word that's making big waves in our classrooms. The word is.... 'yet'. Coined by American psychologist, Carol Dweck, 'yet' is a powerful three letter word that helps learners understand that learning is an ongoing journey and requires ongoing perseverance.

So what exactly is 'the power of yet'? Simply put, 'yet' is a belief. A belief that we all have the ability and power to improve. Over the last 2 weeks, our students have been guided in identifying the skills and knowledge they could not master once upon a time, but through perseverance have been able to achieve. They also had the opportunity to reflect upon the skills and knowledge they would like to master and then consider the steps they would have to take to achieve their goal.

'Yet' focuses on 8 simple ideas to foster a growth mindset

- 1. Allow and encourage retries
- 2. Rethink deadlines as some learners need less or more time
- 3. Praise the process not just the outcome
- 4. Speed doesn't equal learning...understanding is key
- 5. Use failure as a learning tool
- Encourage creativity and alternative methods....
- Teach students how to set goals so they know where they are heading
- 8. Teach students how to be reflective


At home, you can use the above ideas, but also consider where your child uses the word 'can't'.


Then insert the word 'yet' on the end.

I can't ride a bike...yet.

I can't bake a cake...yet. I can't tap dance...yet.

Using 'yet' ignites a 'can do' attitude! It creates an encouraging environment. But our students also learnt that it isn't all roses...they must be willing to learn from their mistakes...to persevere!! It requires patience and it requires belief in yourself. We're all on a learning journey and success is inevitable and right around the corner... if you persevere!
