## **MOTHERS' DAY**

Families are welcome to join us on Friday May 12th for our Mother's Day Celebrations. We begin with our Mother's Day Breakfast on the back playground from 8:00am. This will be followed by our **Mother's Day Mass at 9:15am** at

our OLMC Parish. Students will line up with their class groups and go to their classroom for rolls to be marked. Classes will then line up in assembly lines on the back playground where parents/carers are able to collect them for Mass. Some pews will be reserved for our readers and grades.



## SCHOOL PHOTO DAY REMINDER

On Monday 15 May our annual school photos are scheduled. Families are asked to ensure their child is wearing their full school uniform, which includes navy blue socks or tights for girls and grey socks for boys (not white). Boys must also ensure they are wearing their school tie. Hairstyles must be inline with school policy. Any hair that is longer than shoulder length must be tied back. Hair ties must be yellow, blue or black. *As we know many children will go get a haircut over the weekend, we ask families to NOT have lines shaved in, hair shorter than a number 2 or mullets.* Family portraits will begin at 8:30am in the COSCH area, teaching staff will support family photos, parents are not required. Ordering details are on the last three pages of the newsletter.

## LEAVE FOR HOLIDAYS OR SHORT BREAKS

Families are reminded that if you are taking **ANY leave consisting of two (2) or more days** this must be approved by the Principal. Leave consisting of more than 2 days **CAN NOT** be submitted through COMPASS as it requires approval. Leave forms can be obtained from the school office or school website. All leave must be submitted as early as possible with a minimum of at least two weeks prior to your intended leave.

## CHILD PROTECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR PARENTS

Families are once again invited to attend a school based Child Protection briefing on Tuesday 16 May at 6:30pm in the Library. Any parent or carer who wishes to volunteer at any school event (excursions, sports days etc) must attend a briefing every 2 years, no exceptions. The aim of the briefing is to clarify the online components of the child protection process, the expectations of parent volunteers, specifically around privacy. ## FIRST ACT OF RECONCILIATION



Last week our student leaders attended a very significant reconciliation event for our local area. The students were immersed into the Aboriginal culture through a traditional welcoming ceremony and then participated in a range of workshops exploring the didgeridoo, storytelling, song and dance, sport, face painting, art and cultural artefacts. They also learnt about the first act of reconciliation ever recorded. Some families may not be aware, but on 3 May in 1805, a group of Aboriginal women arranged a meeting on Prospect Hill with



Rev John Marsden. This group of Darug women instigated the meeting to try to bring an end to the violence that had occurred between settlers and the local Aboriginal population. This act on Prospect Hill, in the suburb we now call Pemulwuy, was the first act of reconciliation in Australia. 218 years later, we acknowledge and admire the strength and determination these women must have had to overcome the

many barriers they faced to place reconciliation at the forefront of the agenda and aim to represent within our community in the same way.

## **CANTEEN NEWS - LUNCH ORDERS**

Our roof replacement work will mean that our children have limited access to the canteen for the next three weeks. Children will not be able to go to the canteen to buy their lunch without having a lunch order. The counter service at the canteen is only for snacks and treats after the children have eaten their lunches.

## **PAYMENTS VIA QKR**

**PAYMENTS:** We ask all families to follow correct procedure regarding payments via QKR. Just like our community, we are very much moving towards a cashless society. For school events, functions or sporting days, if you are asked to pay via QKR we expect all families to do so. As a school we do not have any money onsite and can not give change. Events, such as the mothers day stall, are set up to lessen the load on parents to find cash (that we usually don't have at home) but also to streamline the day for our volunteers. Students turning up with money puts us in a position that we may need to turn that child away, something we never want to do. Thanks to those parents who got on board, were organised and followed the procedures, our first cashless Mothers' Day stall was a success. If you are unsure or having difficulties with QKR, please contact the office.

**UPDATING INFORMATION:** Please update your child's details including their class on the QKR app. Please check that a profile is showing for each child and check that all information is correct for the current school year. This enables us to deliver uniforms to the correct classroom and also allocate payments correctly.
