Dear Parents/ Carers,

The annual Our Lady of Mount Carmel Cross Country Carnival will be held on **Thursday 2nd March 2023**. This is a normal school day and lessons will continue as normal before and after the students have run in their event.

The course for Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 students will be within the school grounds. The course for the students from Year 2 (8 year olds only) to Year 6 will be marked out around the school perimeter. All students will participate in the Cross Country Carnival. Qualification for the Diocesan Cross Country is dependent upon students completing the course within a specific time.

Time:

All children are to arrive at school no later than 8.50am. Races will commence at approximately 9:10 am and finish by 11.00 am. We are unable to give a specific time for your child's race as last minute changes to the program are often required.

Parents are welcome to come and watch the events but must remain in the designated spectator area.

Parent Helpers:

Parent helpers are required for checkpoints along the course to ensure the safety of our students. Please complete the attached form if you are able to help on the day.

Student Requirements:

- Students must also have a filled water bottle marked with their name
- Students will need to remain with their age group
- Students will race in the age that they have turned **OR** will be turning in 2023
