NAME OF IN-SCHOOL EXPERIENCE: Cumberland Place Plan Opportunity

PURPOSE OF IN-SCHOOL EXPERIENCE: The Cumberland City Council Place and Activation team are currently developing the Cumberland Place Plan and are interested in gaining feedback from our Year 6 students.

During the in-school experience, the students of Year 6 will have the opportunity to be involved in shaping the way Cumberland Council design and develop the places where they live, learn, play, and eventually work.

The in-school experience will be structured as a forum-style discussion. The Council will provide a short presentation from the Place Team and an introduction to how planners use maps and data to plan how a city grows from our Urban Strategy and Planning Team.

The students will be given the opportunity to discuss factors that influence their perceptions of the liveability of places. They will be surveyed about the following:

- features and characteristics of the places they frequent
- which features in their neighborhoods that they feel support and enhance their wellbeing
- where they spend time now, where they feel safe and where they don't
- talk about their aspirations: What they would like to see here or have seen in other areas
